We are pleased to introduce a diverse range of Club Activities for the academic session 2026-27. These clubs are designed to provide students with opportunities to explore their interests, develop new skills, and nurture creativity beyond the classroom.

The club programme aims to promote experiential learning, teamwork, leadership, and holistic development. Students will be encouraged to participate actively and discover their unique talents, every Friday in the 4th and 5th period.

Details of Clubs Offered

1. Mathematics Club – The Mathletes Club

Enhance logical reasoning and problem-solving skills through puzzles, games, and mathematical challenges.

2. Eco Club – The Earth Ember Club

Promotes environmental awareness, sustainability practices, and responsibility towards nature.

3. Computer Club – Tech Titans Club

Develops digital literacy, coding skills, and an understanding of emerging technologies.

4. Art Club – The Artopian Club

Encourages creativity through drawing, painting, and various forms of visual expression.

5. Music Club – Raag 'O' Rhythm Club

Provides exposure to vocal and instrumental music, fostering rhythm and musical appreciation.

6. Dance Club – Mudra Makers Club

Explores different dance forms and enhances expression, coordination, and confidence.

7. Sports Club – Goal Getters Club

Focuses on physical fitness, teamwork, and sportsmanship through various indoor and Outdoor games.

8. Theatre Club – Rangmanch Club

Explores acting, stagecraft and teamwork to create memorable performances and build confidence

9. Calligraphy - Classic Curvature Club

Develops neat handwriting and artistic lettering skills.

10. Cooking Club – Swaad Saviours Club

Introduces basic culinary skills, healthy eating habits, and creativity in food preparation without fire.

13. Aero-Modelling – IPGS Aviators Club

We are introducing the Aero-Modelling Program (Level 1) for Grades III–VII in collaboration with Mindwize Academy Experiential Learning. The program will be conducted during school hours, with one 1-hour session per week, starting April 2026, for a total of 24 hours or till 31st March 2027 (whichever is earlier).

The fee is ₹3100/- including sessions, kit and take-home 3 flying models. Interested parents are requested to send the exact amount in a labelled sealed envelope along with an almanac note mentioning the amount. The teacher will acknowledge receipt in the almanac.

Important Guidelines:

- All clubs are conducted in-house by school faculty, except Aero Modelling, which is facilitated by external professionals and includes an additional fee.
- Regular participation is mandatory, and students are expected to maintain discipline and enthusiasm.

Schedule & Allotment

- Club activities will be conducted during designated school hours. (Every Friday, 4th and 5th period)
- Final club allotment will be based on student preference and availability of seats.
- Detailed schedules and group lists will be shared shortly.
